

Kersey Parish Precept and Council Tax

The Parish Council has set its budget for 2017/18 and agreed the precept received from Babergh, which will be £7,340. This would make an increase of 6.8% for a band D property; in monetary terms this was a £2.56 increase for the year. Therefore, the Kersey Parish element of council tax will be £40.00 for a band D property. The main reason for this increase in the budget was the maintenance of the defibrillator and the Village Emergency Telephone System which it was agreed were of real benefit to the residents and a new charge for website hosting.
